

Rules

- 1. All stock and produce entered must be property of the person in whose name it is entered. In case of protest, an affidavit will be demanded. All exhibits, except livestock, must be the product of the exhibitor or his family. No bought or borrowed goods or articles will be allowed.**
- 2. No person will be allowed to take more than one prize in any one section. This does not apply to livestock**
- 3. No stud, except foals and yearlings, shall be allowed to show with geldings. Any exhibitor showing a stud does so at own risk.**
- 4. Stock, produce etc. to be exhibited must be named to the Secretary on the entry form enclosed or on the web site**
- 5. In cases where there is no competition, or livestock not in proper condition, it is left to the judge to award first, second, or third prize, according to merit**
- 6. All manufactured articles must have been manufactured this season by the exhibitor and all grain, seeds, roots, and garden products must have been grown in the course of this year, and by the exhibitor, excepting Home craft and Fine arts which must have been done in the last 2 years. Any person violating this rule will forfeit all prizes taken at the show.**
- 7. A certificate of pedigree is required for purebred cattle**
- 8. No person shall be allowed in the show room during the time of inspection by the judges, excepting the officers of the society**
- 9. All bulls and other wild and vicious animals must be well secured before entering the field of exhibition**
- 10. EVERYTHING, EXCEPTING LIVESTOCK AND IMPLEMENTS, MUST BE ON GROUNDS OR IN THE BUILDINGS BY 11 AM ON TUESDAY AND REMAIN UNTIL 4:30 PM ON THE FOLLOWING DAY OR PRIZE MONEY MAY BE FORFEITED. ALL LIVESTOCK MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS BY 11 AM ON WEDNESDAY, AND REMAIN IN THEIR DESIGNATED TIE AREA UNTIL 4 PM OR PRIZE MONEY MAY BE FORFEITED**
- 11. While directors will take every possible precaution under circumstances to secure the safety of the articles sent to the exhibition, the owners themselves must take the risk of exhibition, and should any article be accidentally injured, lost, or stolen, the directors will give any aid in their power towards its recovery, but will not payment for value thereof.**
- 12. The decision of the judges shall be final as to the awarding of prizes and no appeal will be considered except in case of protests. All protests shall be made in writing, and shall be delivered with one hour of the award to the secretary's office. Any exhibitor or interested person making such protest will be required to deposit the sum of \$5.00 and if such protest is not sustained, the said sum shall be retained by the association. The directors reserve the right in all cases to interpret their own rules.**

SPECIAL NOTE:

- 13. The exhibitor agrees to indemnify and save harmless the society and the Township of Wellesley from and against all loss or damage by reason of the use by the user. The exhibitor must have proof of certificate of not less than \$1,000,000. Exhibitors include all livestock, commercial and midway participants. The directors reserve the right to deny participation to those without proper insurance coverage**
- 14. Any persons found guilty of violating any part of the rules will forfeit their whole prize money.**
- 15. Membership is \$6.00 per year. Entry fee for horses, sheep, and cattle, 15% of winnings will only deducted from horse classes.**
- 16. Exhibitors are restricted to Ontario residents only. The judges in the hall commence at 12:30 pm on Tuesday. Horses judged at 11:00 am on Wednesday. Other livestock 1:00 pm Wednesday. Parties taking prize money amounting to \$6.00 or more are compelled to leave \$6.00 with the secretary for next year's membership. This also applies to special prizes. All cheques not cashed by December 31st in the year awarded, will become the property of the Society. Secretary will send cheques for prize money by mail.**

Special Note

No two prizes will be awarded to any exhibitor for the same description of produce or articles of manufacture and no two persons may show the same product from the same factory, farm, or garden. All exhibits to be removed at 4:30 pm Wednesday.

Please Note
